## What is EMCC?

The EMCC-Course (Emergency Medicine Core Competences) is a Europe-wide intensive 3-day simulation-based course in Emergency Medicine.

## Course Objectives

The proximate goal of the EMCC is to boost core competences of EM through intensive scenario-based training and group discussion. The ultimate goal of the course is to promote the development of scenario-based, regularly recurring training in EM at the level of individual training programs in Emergency Medicine. In addition, the EMCC promotes checklists as a tool to deliver safe and efficient patient care.

## Competences the EMCC-Course focuses on:

- ✓ Likelihood Assessment and Decision-Making Scenarios
- ✓ Examination & "Hands On" Skills – Neurology, Ophthalmology, ENT, Airway
- ✓ ECG Interpretation
- ✓ Procedures - (neonatal) Resuscitation, EM-Delivery, Orthopaedics
- ✓ Acid-Base Scenarios
